Subject: Minutes from the summer clinic

- 2:04- President Kilbreth opened the summer clinic of the SCTCCCA. He introduced Coach Bob Pollock of Clemson University and his assistant, Coach Mike Brooks. President Kilbreth made the following opening remarks:
  - 1. As was noted in the April 1988, SCHSL BULLETIN, there will not be any required rules clinics for any sport; so, there will not be a reson to schedule any extra track rules clinics other than the winter meeting.
  - 2. Coach John Jones of Spring Valley High will continue as the meet director of the state cross country meet. The 4A athletic directors turned down our proposal for 4 teams to qualify from each region. The state meet entry forms for cross country are to be returned to Coach Ed Boehmke of Eastside High. Our association will continue to give the All-State t-shirts for the top 15 individuals.
  - 3. A directive will be sent out to the lower upper state meet directors from the SCHSL concerning track. The format for the state track meet will remain the same, except the pole vault and high jump will start earlier and will be separated by classification. Since the Metro Conference track meet will be at USC on the second weekend of May, the state track meet will be held on the 19th and 20th of May, 1989. The 4x400m relay will be seeded on time in the preferred lanes. The 300m hurdles will finish on the "common finish line". At the Lower/Upper State qualifying meets: the discus, long jump, shot put, and triple jump contestants will have 3 trials, and the 5 best contestants will get 3 more attempts.

  - 5. A note of thanks to Coach Charlie Strong(track coach at USC) for his support; also, a note of thanks to Chris and Catherine Lempesis(and the Richland District 2 administrative staff) for helping with the concessions at the state track meet.
  - 6. The Coaches Classic Track Meet will be held on the 8 April, 1989, at Socastee High.
- 2:16- The minutes of the winter clinic and a financial statement was given by LF Sanders, Bell Street Middle. As of 1 January, 1988, the association had an account of \$3634.94. In seven months, we have deposited \$3574.00, taken out

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\$1905.13, for a balance of \$5303.81 in the black. Coach George Johnson of Brookland-Cayce High moved that the association accept the minutes as written. Coach Barry Knight of Wren High seconded. It passed.

2:20- A ballot for the purpose of electing new officers and the Shrine Bowl Run assistant coach was passed out.

2:25- The coach of the year awards was presented by President Kilbreth.
