The President recognize Mr. Ed Harmon in helping pay for these awards.

19:54- Coach Jenkins ask the association to pick rep. for National Coach of the year. Nom: Girls track: Catherine Lempesis, Spring Valley and Ted Whitaker, Hilton Head. Boys track: Rut Dingle, Sumter, Willie Wooden, Riverside, and John Jones, Spring Valley. Cross Country: Jim Kilbreth, Spartanburg and Willie Wooden, Riverside.

Eileen Kilbreth of Spartanburg was voted as the assis. coach for the Shrine Bowl Run. She will assist the head coach: Willie Wooden.
