16:15- Coach Sanders read the minutes from the winter clinic.
Wil Lampkin(Stratford) moved that the minutes be approved.
Jackie O'Rourke(Wando) seconded. It pass. Our current
account with the Bank of America is \$2379.54.

16:20- COY awards were given out by Kevin Shaw(Spring Valley).
The winners for track: Gil Cade, Belton-HP= Girls 3A; Ezekiel
Goode, Emerald= Girls 2A; Andy Hallman, Barnwell= Boys
2A(not present); Richard Iuden, St. Andrews= Boys 3A;
Mike Moore, Irmo= Girls 4A; Stevie Phillips, Johnsonville=
Girls 1A(not present); Steve Robinson,Boys 4A; Jackie
Ryant, St. George= Boys 1A; and Shelby Strother, Hampton-H. *GIRLS 2A*

16:25= Coach Sanders presented a special award to Jami Mitchell
of Crestwood High for setting a new state record in
the 200m dash.

16:30- A special election for the position of president was held.
Kevin Shaw was elected. This position is for only
one year. A special election was held for Coach Shaw's VP
position, with Steve Wison(Summerville) being pick.

state track meet be scored for 8 places. It was seconded by

metals(ribbons for the Coaches Association) for the
relay events at the state meet. It was seconded by
Coach Glover Smiley(Spartanburg). It pass.

16:55- Coach Chris Worrock(Belton-HP) wanted to know from
Jerome Singleton(SCHSL= Yes, he actually was still
there) why he could not bring his whole team to the
state meet for free. President Shaw suggested that
he (Coach Worrock) report back to the Track Coaches
Association at the winter clinic, on a number to be pass
on to the HSL.

17:08- Coach Jones proposed that the girls pole vault be
a scoring event for the 2001 year. Coach ~~O'Rourke~~
seconded. It pass.(35-6)

17:25- Coach O'Rourke proposed that the girls be held this
year(2000) state track meet as an exhibition. It was
seconded by Coach Lampkin. It pass.
President Shaw announce that Karen Gillespie(Riverside) will
be the assistant coach for the Shrine Bowl Run. President
Shaw then set the winter meeting for 22 Jan., 2000 , at the
HSL office in Columbia. He then adjourn the meeting.
