SCTCCCA Board	Singleton Scholarship changes	The SCTCCCA Board proposed changes to the Singleton Scholarship. 2nd by Matt Feiling (Byrnes). There was discussion. The current scholarship is \$500 from the SCTCCCA. If outside groups donate to the SS fund, the scholarship amount will be increased by the amount donated. If extra SCTCCCA funds are available at the time, the scholarship amount may be increased at the discretion of the board with a maximum of \$2,500.
