Ed Boehmke (Eastside)	Cross country qualifying procedure	Ed proposed the following: Propose that we continue the cross country qualifying procedure that was used for the 2020 season with the exception of ALL teams be invited to their respective classification qualifier. Rankings will continue to be used to decide which of the two races a team will run. The top six from each race in each classification will continue to qualify for the state championships for a total of twelve. Sites and times will be determined by the SCTCCCA Board. 2nd by Rich Wideman (West Florence). There was discussion. There was a suggestion for Ed to amend his proposal from twelve to sixteen teams. Ed agreed. So Ed amended his original proposal read sixteen teams instead of twelve. Call to question by Rachel Lindman (Spring Valley).	Proposal passed unanimously.

There was a suggestion for Ed to amend his proposal as follows: Propose that the SCTCCCA board request that the cross country state championships take place in the week of November 13, 2021 of the SCHSL calendar, and that this date is set before the principals and AD's conference in March so qualifying locations can be determined. Chris White (Seneca)	Amendment to Coleman-Singleton Scholarship	Chris proposed the following: Propose changes be made to the By-Laws for the Coleman-Singleton Scholarship by adding the words "with at least one season occurring during their senior year" in sub-section A. In sub-section B the following wording will be eliminated "All SCTCCCA officers will vote on their top 3 selections and the winner will be tabulated by the president (or appointee)". This will be replaced by "A committee of 5 members will be assembled to review all applications and vote on the scholarship awardee. The committee will be developed by the SCTCCCA president or his/her appointee, and should be good standing members of 10 or more years". There was a 2nd by David Lee (James Island).
